Once a year, *Henley & Partners* honors an inspirational global citizen whose extraordinary achievements have improved our global community and contributed to a more just, peaceful, and tolerant world.

What do we look for?

The Award Committee typically looks for an inspirational individual who demonstrates extraordinary vision, courage, and commitment in contributing to the advancement of a global issue, whether this is social, political or environmental. The candidate's work should demonstrate a positive impact on the lives of the most vulnerable groups in society.

The Award

The Award itself consists of a specially made commemorative medal, an honorary certificate signed by the President of the Award Committee, and a contribution of USD 25,000 to help the recipient continue their excellent work. An equal share of the prize is donated in support of the longstanding partnership between *Henley & Partners* and the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR).

The 2017 laureate will be selected by a seven-member Award Committee and honored at the annual *Henley & Partners* Global Residence and Citizenship Conference, which will be held this year in Hong Kong on Thursday, 16 November 2017. The selection process is confidential and the final decision is made by a majority vote.
